



ARABIAN TRAIL AND RANCH HORSE ASSOCIATION HIGH POINT PROGRAM

Open to all Amateur and Junior members of AHA who are in good standing and showing a registered Purebred or Half-Arabian Horse.

Only AHA Recognized classes in English and Western Trail, Ranch Riding, Ranch Rail, Ranch Trail, and VRH Limited Ranch Cow Work (B,D,B,D) at AHA recognized show will count towards the high point awards.

Open, AOTR, and AATR, and ATR Classes will count for Adult Amateur riders. Open, JOTR, JTR and ATR classes will count for Junior riders.

Any horse show that requires qualifications to participate in, such as a Regional, Youth Nationals, Mid Summer Nationals or US Nationals, do not count towards the high point award.

Enrollment fee of \$25.00 for entry, must be paid in full before points will be applied.

The show year will begin December 1st and end November 30th of each year.

Points will not be counted for shows prior to enrollment.

Horse show notification form must be completed and turned into the High Point Secretary within 28 days after the last day of the show, otherwise no points will be awarded.

Points to be counted for rider/horse, not horse or rider only. A rider can enroll multiple horses but they will be entered separately.

2 Tiers for both Adult Amateur and Junior exhibitor:
1-3 shows, 4 or more shows, within the show year.

Concurrent shows will count as two shows.

Points will be accumulated as follows:

1 point for every horse shown, judged and placed above with a maximum of 15 points given. (16 or more horses will count as a max. of 15 points for 1st place and work down from there.)

Example: Placing 1st with 5 horses entered. 4 points
 Placing 1st with 11 horses entered. 10 points.
 Placing 1st with 24 horses entered. 15 points
 Placing 5th with 17 horses entered. 11 points

Point standings will be posted quarterly on the In the Ring With The Arabian Trail and Ranch Horse Facebook page. It is the responsibility of the participant to review their points.

Any questions or discrepancies must be reported with the High Point Secretary within 14 days of posting. After that period, no adjustments will be made.

High Point awards to be awarded in February at the Scottsdale All Arabian Horse Show. Recipient need not be present to receive their award.
